

NRA Approved Longrange Prone Rifle Match

Burbank Rifle and Revolver Club

Dates: Feb 25, Mar 26, Apr 22, June 25, July 23, August 26, Sept 24, Oct 28, Dec 16, 2023

Location: Burbank Rifle and Revolver Club, North of Castaic, CA. Templin Highway Exit.

Entry Fee: \$20.00 for Burbank Rifle and Revolver Club members and \$25 for non-members. Active-duty military will not be charged an entry fee. NRA points are not acceptable.

Eligibility: Entries are open to all.

Range/Distance: Match shall be shot at 1000 yards

Course of Fire: Competitors will shoot a total 60 rounds for record. This will consist of three stages of 20 rounds each with unlimited sighters in a time limit of 30 minutes. F-Class shooters will use the LR-F targets. Sling shooters will use LR targets. Electronic targets will be used for scoring.

Rifles and Sights Rules: Current NRA High Power Rifle rules apply. The match is open to any rifle conforming to NRA HP Rifle Rule 3.2 and any sight" conforming to NRA rule 3.7(c).

3.2 Any Rifle - A rifle with no restrictions on sights or accessories, except that it must be safe to competitors and range personnel. Ammunition will be restricted to no larger than .35 caliber.

3.7 Sights (c) Any - Any sight without restriction as to material or construction.

3.16.1 Compensators and Muzzle Brakes -The use of compensators or muzzle brakes is prohibited. (The California legal muzzle device on M1A's is exempted from this restriction).

Protests and challenges shall be decided by the Executive Officer, whose decision shall be final.

F Class - F-class scores will be used to determine match winner. F-class scores will be submitted to the NRA and will be used for classification separately under the NRA's statistic guidelines. F-Class competitors will shoot on the correct NRA F-Class target.

Classification of Competitors: NRA Longrange rifle classifications will be used. If unclassified or unable to show classification, you may be placed in Master Unclassified.

Awards: To be determined by Match Director.

Squadding: Shooters must register at www.brrc.org. Walkups may be accepted if room is available. Limit of 20 entries. Relays will be assigned by the Match Director.

Starting Time: Check-in starts at 0730 with match starting between 0815 and 0830.

Scoring: Electronic targets will be used for scoring. Shooters should bring a mobile phone or tablet with an internet browser. Shooters are expected to serve as scorekeepers and verifiers.

General Information: Restrooms are available at the range. No restaurants or other facilities at the range. Shooters should bring ample water to ensure proper hydration and food as needed. Smoking restricted to limited areas. No alcoholic beverages or pets. No steel core or steel jacketed ammunition. Failure to comply with all range rules will disqualify shooter from match and shooter may be expelled from the range. Hearing protection is required. Use of Empty Chamber Indicator is mandatory at all times except during preparation period and match stages.
