Burbank Rifle and Revolver Club, Los Angeles, CA NRA Approved High Power Rifle Tournament (200, 300, and 600 Yards)

The Tournaments at BRRC are held to promote participation in NRA High Power Rifle competition, to promote good sportsmanship and rifle marksmanship, and for competitors to establish NRA High Power Rifle classifications in "Across the Course" competition at full distances (200/300/600 yards). NRA membership is highly encouraged but not required.

2020 Tournament Dates (2nd Saturday of the Month): Jan 11, Feb 8, Mar 14, Apr 11, May 9, June 13, July 11, Sept 12, Oct 10, Nov 14. *There are not approved matches in August and December, instead we will conduct an "all offhand", 60 shot club match/practice.*

Course of Fire: The 80 Shot Regional Course, maximum range of 600 yards, and 2 sighters at each stage: 20 shots Standing at 200 yards, slow fire (SR target); 2 strings of 10 shots each sitting at 200 yards, rapid fire, 60 seconds (SR target); 2 strings of 10 shots each prone at 300 yards, rapid fire, 70 seconds (SR-3 target); and 20 shots prone at 600 yards, slow fire (MR-1 target). E-Targets will normally be used for the 200 yard and 600 yard stages. E-targets may be used at 300 yards if e-target resources are available. The format may be changed to the National Match Course (50 shots), or other variations of the stages listed above, and reduced targets may be used, as range conditions dictate.

Rules: Current NRA High Power Rules will apply. Empty chamber indicators are required. Rifle categories include Service Rifle, Rule 3.1 (a), (b), (c), (d); 3.2 Any Rifle; 3.3 NRA Match Rifle; and 3.3.2 NRA Any Sight Match Rifle/Tactical Rifle. Eye and ear protection is required. Any disregard for safety, at the discretion of the match officials, may result in disqualification from the match and/or expulsion from the range.

Eligibility and Entries: Entries are open to all, Fee is \$25.00 which includes NRA match registration fee of \$4.50. No charge to active duty military personnel. NRA points not accepted. Entries are to be made electronically at <u>www.brrc.org</u>, advanced entries are strongly encouraged. Match Day: Entry confirmation and squadding from 7:00 to 7:45 AM.

Walk-On entries, or late arrivals after 7:45 AM may be accepted at the Match Director's discretion. No Entries accepted by mail.

Club guests (ie non-members) will sign a waiver of liability before being allowed to compete, which can be downloaded at **www.brrc.org/resources/Documents/BRRC_Release_Form.pdf.** This form must be signed for each match attended.

Entry Limits: Entries are limited to 21 shooters, preference given to pre-entries by email, up to the day before the match.

Firing Starts: 8:30 am, Shooters, scorekeepers, and target pullers in position at that time.

Targets & Scoring: The match will use electronic targets for some or all stages of the match (depending on the number of shooters and available e-target resources). Competitors should bring a wifi capable smart phone, tablet, computer, etc. to access the electronic target system. For those unfamiliar with electronic target use instruction will be provided. Non firing competitors will act as scorekeepers on the firing line while electronic targets are in use. If some or all of the match is conducted on manually pulled targets competitors are expected to perform scoring and pit duty.

Challenge fee is \$2.00, which will be refunded on winning the challenge. As practical, pit duties be evenly divided amongst competitors, balanced against minimizing match duration. Competitors withdrawing early must secure a replacement for target pulling and scoring duties.

Awards: Cash Awards will be given as follows, Match Winner, High Match Rifle or High Service Rifle, and Class Winners. Classes and Categories may be combined to maximize awards.

Classification of Competitors: NRA high power rifle classifications will be used. Competitors unclassified or unable to show classification, may be placed in Master Unclassified.

Match Cancellation: RAIN CANCELLS! This may include rain prior to match day, which may make the range dirt roads impassable. IF THE ROAD DOWNRANGE IS WET, DO NOT DRIVE ON THE ROAD! If there has been rain in the Castaic area (including the Los Angeles basin) during the week preceding the match, <u>use the Contact Information below to verify that the match will be held</u>, and to receive email announcements regarding range conditions.

General Information: Competitors and spectators must provide their own drinking water, food and shade. No potable water, food or electricity is available. There is no telephone service, and cell phone coverage is almost non-existent. Portable lavatory facilities are available at the firing line. Overnight camping by non-members is available on a limited basis by prior arrangement only. Accommodations are available in nearby Castaic. No trash pickup, take out what you bring in.

Range Directions: Take Interstate 5 to the Templin Hwy off-ramp (about. 6 miles north of Castaic). At the foot of the Templin Hwy off-ramp, turn east. About 100 feet east of I-5 turn left (north) onto Paradise Ranch Road. Proceed about 200 yards over the rise in the road to where the paved road forks; go right at the fork. Continue until past the RV park and the old horse track. Near the end of the paved road, the road turns left and transitions to a narrow dirt road. Follow the dirt road past two entry gates, and proceed to the range and park.
